



# Freedom from Homosexuality through Jesus Christ

*Hope for Wholeness exists so that those who struggle with homosexuality can find freedom to live according to God's design. Genesis 1:27*

Dear Pastor,

I'm excited for this opportunity to introduce myself and Hope for Wholeness, which I have been privileged to steward over the last 18 years.

In 1991, the Lord led me away from a life in homosexuality, where I had developed many relationships and many deep rooted addictions. He led me to jump feet first into His church, getting baptized, digging into His Word, daily sermons, Bible fellowship groups, choir, and quickly getting involved in leadership.

In 1995 I met Julie, whom I'd been praying for every day since accepting Jesus into my heart. We dated for six months, engaged for six months, and wed. That was 21 years ago, and I don't regret anything. She's the love of my life. She knows all my good and bad points, as we together lead our family around the cross of Christ. My son Seth, now 17, and my daughter Caroline 15, have both accepted Christ as Lord at a young age. We are fortunate enough to have had both of them in Christian education their whole life. It is our aim that our family is a beacon to those who are far from God, seeing that all things are possible through a submitted relationship to Jesus Christ.

In 1999, the Lord laid it on my heart to start this ministry, formerly called Truth Ministry. With my wife and my church by my side, I stepped out in faith. With a heart filled with fear and hope, I stepped forward believing He would catch me and He has always been found faithful.

In 2011, we created the a ground breaking curriculum specifically for those affected by homosexuality, titled Hope for Wholeness. The curriculum consists of 18 videos, featuring many testimonies of men and women who've walked away from homosexuality, and 15 nationally recognized experts on the subject including Joe Dallas, Janelle Hallman, Christopher Yuan, and June Hunt. HFW Referrals receive and utilize the curriculum as being a part of HFW. Many around the world have been helped by this curriculum.

In 2013, simultaneous to the closure of our national organization, Exodus International, I felt lead to create a national network that would continue to honor God and the work of the Holy Spirit on those who experience same-sex attraction and their families. Not even knowing of the oncoming closure, I emailed the president of Exodus of my decision. He quickly responded, "This is an answer to prayer." He encouraged all the remaining members of Exodus to join Hope for Wholeness and said in an interview, "Hope for Wholeness represents the best that was Exodus."

In 2015, I wrote my first book *The Transparent Life*, where I shared my story and focused on James 5:16, HFW's central message of encouraging openness with those around you to receive prayer and encouragement.
